The issue is largely cosmetic, but the puppies do require extra attention when nursing to make sure they get proper nutrition. Trouble can come with finding a home for puppies born with this condition as surgery to correct the issue can be costly. Luckily for these pups, Dr. Rothbart has always had a soft spot for English Bulldogs. After talking with the breeder, and his wife, Dr. Rothbart made a spot in his home for Harvey. Ashley also stepped up to make sure that Aggie too was well taken care of.



Harvey is adjusting well to playing gently with Dr. Rothbart's two cats. And Aggie is learning how to be a dog from Ashley's Great Dane named Dallas. Another interesting extra in these two pups, they have seven upper incisors instead of the normal six. To help keep their mouth and noses clean, or as clean as a bulldog face ever gets, Dr. Rothbart will be fixing their cleft lips at the time of spay and neuter.
